Supply List for Direct Fabric Dyeing

If you have shied away from dyeing before because of time or supplies, this method is for you. Using quart jars is less mess and less time! You will make 24 fat quarters of beautiful fabric and all so easy. Come join us in fabric dyeing the color wheel. Using quart jars is less mess and less time! You will make 24 fat quarters of beautiful fabric. In the afternoon we will use one fat quarter and make a heart or flag. Dyeing directly on the fabric.

I will supply dye concentrate (mixed for your use) and all the auxiliary chemicals, handouts with the recipe and instructions for your reference and dyed samples. 1/4 yd. of fabric for afternoon direct dyeing. And you will be taking Synthrapol home to wash your fabric





Supplies

- Old clothes
- Rubber gloves
- Sponge and paper towels for cleanups
- Small scissors
- Grocery bags to carry dyed items home
- 2 gallon bucket or dishpan
- One dozen quart jars with lids and screw tops (large mouth preferred). If you want to use plastic cups-yogurt containers, zip lock bags-they must hold 16 oz. of liquid.
- 1 cup measuring with a spout, clear 1/2 oz. and 1/4 oz. measuring marks.
- 6 yards of PFD white fabric. If you do not have this fabric. Wash your fabric before coming to the class, also tear it into 24 fat quarter pieces.
- You also have the option of dyeing a tee-shirt. 100% tee shirt if you want.
- \$5 for supplies, I also sell PFD cotton lawn white fabric for \$5 a yd.
