Supply List for 2 x 2 Blocks for Pigs

The objective of this class is to learn the Snip & Flip technique. It is best to start with four blocks. This project is raw edge machine appliqué. It is fun and easy to do.

A complete instruction and pattern for the quilt shown below will be include in this class. Students will have the choice of one of nine different animal patterns. You can download the supply list from my website for the choice you like.

If you want to make more blocks, bring more colored applique fabric, background fabric, sashing and border fabrics.

- 1- Sharp scissors, pencil and pins to trace and cut animals.
- 2- Sewing machine, with zigzag foot, decorative thread for machine embroidery, cotton thread for piecing.
- 3- Rulers, rotary cuter, an iron with a protective applique sheet.
- 4- Basic sewing machine supplies.
- 5- Backing and batting to fit quilt.
